## **SUBJECT INTENT FOR: Geography**

## Our Geography Curriculum:

#### *Is broad, relevant and enriched:*

Children will have access to resources, teaching and activities that are current, relevant and promote curiosity about the wider world.

It is our intent that geography should be learnt inside and outside the classroom; children will be given opportunities to explore and experience the human and physical world in many different contexts.

#### **Develops character:**

The geography curriculum will provoke questioning about the human and natural world and develop a range of investigation and problem-solving skills that are transferable across all subjects.

The geography curriculum will encourage children to take responsibility for their actions and teach that decisions made by them can affect the human and physical world further afield.

### Helps children make a positive contribution:

The geography curriculum intends to inspire curiosity and fascination about our world and help children take a responsible attitude towards the world around them that inspires life-long learning.

## Ensures children are knowledgeable, skilled and ready:

Teaching should equip pupils with knowledge about diverse places, people, resources and natural and human environments. Children will be knowledgeable about interactions between the human and physical world and understand how the earth's features are interconnected and change over time.

The geography curriculum will enable children to be confident to understand and ask questions about the world around them.

The geography curriculum intends to ensure children have a greater understanding of the world and their place in it, ready for future experiences of the physical and human world.

## Diversity in Geography:

The geography curriculum will help children to gain a wide understanding of the ethnicities, cultures, languages and religions that our UK society (and the world) is made up of. It will celebrate and highlight the rich heritage of cultural and ethnic diversity in the UK.

## SEND in Geography:

Through a creative and broad geography curriculum, children access their learning with a hands-on approach. There are opportunities for all children to follow the curriculum with a range of fieldwork opportunities as well as exciting, engaging and creative lessons.
