SUBJECT INTENT FOR: History

Our History Curriculum:

Is broad, relevant and enriched:

Children will have access to resources, teaching and activities that are current, relevant and promote fascination and curiosity about the history of Britain's past and that of the wider world.

Develops character:

The history curriculum will inspire fascination and curiosity to know more about the past.

Children will have the opportunity to ask questions, think critically and develop perspective and judgement.

Helps children make a positive contribution:

Our history curriculum will help pupils to understand the complexity of people's lives, the process of change, the diversity of societies and relationships between different groups, as well as their own identity and the challenges of their time.

Ensures children are knowledgeable, skilled and ready:

The curriculum will help pupils gain coherent knowledge and understanding of Britain's past and that of the wider world.

Our history curriculum will equip pupils to ask perceptive questions, think critically, weigh evidence, sift arguments, and develop perspective and judgement ready for future learning in KS3 and 4.

The curriculum will help children understand methods of historical enquiry, including how evidence is used to make historical claims and discern how and why contrasting arguments and interpretations of the past have been constructed.

Diversity in History:

The history curriculum will help children to gain a wide cultural understanding of historical figures. They will look at a diverse range of role models from history who have provided significant changes in history.
